

MINUTES OF VALLEY COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS SITTING AS WOZAB FUND ADVISORY COMMITTEE

The Valley County Board of Supervisors, sitting as the Wozab Fund Advisory Committee, met on Monday, March 9, 2026, at 5:30pm in the Courthouse Boardroom to consider the Wozab Fund applications. Pledge of Allegiance recited, roll call taken: Baker, Petska, DeRiso, VanSlyke present. Absent Baker, Magiera, Stunkel. Clerk verified meeting notice published; agenda posted. Agenda adopted on motion of Petska, second Baker. Carried. Yes: DeRiso, VanSlyke, Baker, Petska. No: none. Absent: Stunkel, Ference, Magiera. Open Meetings Act posted on the west wall; public copies available on the counter. No public comment offered.

Linda Markvicka and Carrie Sheldon spoke on behalf of North Loup Popcorn Days whose application was received late. Baker was absent from the board meeting at 5:37pm and returned at 5:39pm. Sheldon and Markvicka expressed gratitude for past awards. Michelle Zangger spoke on behalf of Central Nebraska Farm Safety 4 Just Kids.

Les Long of NE Community Foundation reviewed all applications for compliance with IRS regulations, spreadsheet with comments provided. There is a total of \$32,289.90 available for awards.
