The Valley County Board of Supervisors met in special session at 7:00pm, Tuesday, August 24, 2026, in the District Courtroom. Pledge of Allegiance recited. Roll call taken: VanSlyke, Ference, Baker, Magiera, Petska, Stunkel present. Absent: DeRiso. Clerk verified meeting notice published; agenda posted. Motion by Petska to adopt the agenda, second Ference. Carried. Yes: Ference, VanSlyke, Baker, Magiera, Stunkel, Petska. No: none. Absent: DeRiso. Public copies of open meetings act and board packets available on speaking podium.

Motion by Ference to enter the hearing on flock cameras at 7:01pm, second Stunkel. Carried. Yes: VanSlyke, Baker, Magiera, Stunkel, Petska, Ference. No: none. Absent: DeRiso. Sheriff Dave Scheideler gave a presentation on the sheriff office's use of the flock cameras, to include types of cases utilized for, an example of the pictures taken using a sheriff's vehicle, and audits. DeRiso arrived at the board meeting at 7:07pm. VanSlyke read a statement for those providing public testimony.
